But before we get into a little bit further what exactly is cultural appropriation?</p> <p>Cultural appropriation is defined as the use of objects or elements of a non-dominant culture in a way that doesn't respect their original meaning or does not give credit to their source. This can be extremely controversial when members of a dominant culture appropriate from minority cultures.</p>
	<p>Many have been accused of cultural appropriation: From celebrities like Justin Bieber, to Adele, Bruno Mars, Rita Ora Kardashians... to social media influencers, to clothing lines like Victoria Secret, Versace. And even food chains like Mc Donald’s</p>

	<p>As this twitter user said, the question is, how do we distinguish cultural appropriation from a tribute?
